These projects build on the natural beauty of Moreton Bay and its existing infrastructure, and will be delivered progressively over a number of years in partnership with local and state governments, industry bodies, local businesses and the Moreton Bay community:

1. Commission a 'Maritime Master Plan' for the region
2. Run an international ideas competition for new infrastructure
3. Establish maritime education & research programs in the region
4. Establish a Bluetech startup ecosystem and technology hubs
5. Host networking, information, community and sporting events
6. Deliver an 'Industry Ecosystem and Economic Impact' study
7. Publish an 'Investment Prospectus'
8. Implement a digital member networking platform
